Annual Assessment and Dues:

The annual dues for 2015-2016 will remain the same as 2014-2015. The Board expressed some concern about a financial issue surfacing, and therefore did not reduce the dues. The net difference is only \$3,000.00. There is over \$300,000.00 in our reserve fund. The assessments will be sent out at the end of January 2016, and are due on March 1, 2016. The assessment is based on an amount of \$150.00 per acre.

Lake / Trails and Fire Safety:

The Board is placing an emphasis on Lake and Trail cleanup in 2015/2016. All the trails have deteriorated since the storms in December 2009. Due to the extreme fire danger, very little work was done on trails or the Lakeshore. If the weather allows, the L/T committee plans some aggressive cleanup on the lake and the trails on both sides of Deerwood Drive.

Input from owners brought up at the Annual Meeting:

USPS mailing cost have been reduced by 50% thanks to those who participate in email distribution of documents. If you would like to receive SHOA required documents via email, instead of USPS, please contact deerwood@earthlink.net to be added to our list. You will also be added to the Emergency Notification Network. *ALL email addresses are confidential and will not be displayed nor given out.*

The Board decided not to publish some of our financial documents on our website, www.shoanews.org

There was a request for a "Neighborhood Watch" program to be formed. The Board had concerns with the level of participation and no action was taken.

Since the law enforcement issue earlier this year, the Board was requested to consider a voluntary plan to provide stickers, about 2"x2", to be placed on owners vehicles. No serial numbers or other data would be collected. The Board was divided and no motion made to allocate funding.
